Measles is an infection that spreads very easily and can cause serious problems in some people.

Measles usually starts with cold-like symptoms, followed by a rash a few days later. Some people may also get small spots in their mouth. The spots of the measles rash are sometimes raised and join together to form blotchy patches. They're not usually itchy.

Measles can spread to others easily so please call your GP surgery before you go in.

**Important:** Stay off nursery, school, or work for at least 4 days from when the rash first appears. Also try to avoid close contact with babies, people who are pregnant and people with weakened immune systems.
